Devotional Reading: 2 Corinthians 5:16 - 21 Background Scripture: 1 John 3:1 - 10

LESSON AIMS: the students will:

INTRODUCTION: The letter, I John, is considered a "general epistle" because it does not identify a specific church, location, or individual as the addressee. The letter was likely written from Ephesus to the churches of Asia Minor - - churches over which John exercised apostolic leadership. Because of God's great love for us, He has reached out to make us His children and while we do not know our ultimate destiny, we <u>do</u> know we will be like Jesus and that glorious transformation. How are we living up to our name of "Christian" as we await His return?

KEY VERSE 3 Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God: therefore the world knoweth us not, because it knew him not.

<u>SUMMARY</u>: Because we believe our destiny is to be like Jesus, this idea of our true identity should move us to be like Him now. John reminds us that when we break the law - - when we sin - - we rebel against God. Any violation of the moral standards that God has revealed to us is rebelliousness. What we do in the flesh matters. False teachers have little concern for morality. John warns us not to be deceived. Those who "do what is sinful" are of the devil, not God.
