## SOLOMON DEDICATES THE TEMPLE

*1 Kings 8:22 – 24, 37 – 39, 46, 48 – 50a* Devotional Reading: Psalm 34:11 – 22 Background Scripture: 1 Kings 8:22 – 53

<u>LESSON AIMS</u>: the students will:

LESSON:

- SUMMARIZE Solomon's prayer
- ANALYZE the structure and movement of Solomon's prayer at the Temple dedication
- WRITE a prayer to dedicate the congregation's meeting places to the Land

<u>INTRODUCTION</u>: The Temple in Jerusalem had taken seven years to build. Solomon had carefully executed the plans left by King David and it was now time to dedicate the Temple to the Lord. He prayed, acknowledging God's divine characteristics, God's love and care for His people; that God is a promise-keeper and He extends forgiveness, kindness, and mercy.

<u>KEY VERSE</u> <sup>38</sup> What prayer and supplication soever be made by any man, or by all thy people Israel, which shall know every man the plague of his own heart, and spread forth his hands toward this house:

*<sup>39</sup> Then hear thou in heaven thy dwelling place, and forgive, and do, and give to every man according to his ways, whose heart thou knowest; (for thou, even thou only, knowest the hearts of all the children of men;) 1 Kings 8:38-39 / KJV*

<u>SUMMARY</u>: Solomon recognized that the Temple was the fulfillment of God's plan. While David and Solomon were human instruments, the work was God's. Solomon emphasized the importance of God's deliverance out of Egypt. Though deliverance had been so many years before, it was as important this time as the day it happened. In his prayer, Solomon acknowledged the nature and character of God, and that God keeps every promise. Solomon prayed that God would dwell in the Temple and honor those who seek Him.
