Psalm 93

Devotional Reading: Isaiah 52:1 - 12

Background Scripture: Psalms 47; 93

LESSON AIMS: the students will:

- IDENTIFY what God is “mightier than”
- COMPARE God’s actions as Creator to His actions as Ruler
- STATE which of Psalm 93’s five verses speak most closely to his or her current situation and why

INTRODUCTION: Throughout the world, there is chaos and disorder. Who can restore order and peace? Today’s text proclaims God as the almighty and creative power whose reign stands firm in this unstable world. One of the most crucial aspects for all who believe is to acknowledge His dominion over the earth. With that acknowledgement, we should also acknowledge His dominion over our lives. This passage is a magnificent reminder that God is God. He reigns over all things in magnificent glory.

KEY VERSE: *93 The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, wherewith he hath girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved.*

Summary: The kings of Babylon gloated over their conquering of Judah. God had allowed the evil nation to correct His people, but God never gives up His sovereign control. Unlike other so-called deity, God is Sovereign. He is holy; He is majestic. We should praise Him for His mighty power and lordship over all creation.
