LESSON AIMS: the students will:

INTRODUCTION: The Book of Hebrews connects the Old Testament with the New Testament by comparing the distinctions between the two. The Book reveals how God's Covenant in the Old Testament differs from that of the New Testament and how the New Testament completes the Old. In Hebrews we understand how Jesus fulfilled the Old Law and became the new and everlasting ransom humanity's sin.

KEY VERSE: ²⁴ For Christ is not entered into the holy places made with hands, which are the figures of the true; but into heaven itself, now to appear in the presence of God for us: Hebrews 9:24
